

# South-East Queensland Congestion Relief Youth Bill 2008

## **1 Clause 10 (Excess charges)**

At page 8, lines 1 to 13—

*omit, insert—*

### **‘10 Credit payments**

- ‘(1) The owner of a registered vehicle using levies exceeding the preliminary level of credit in the owner’s account can purchase additional credit to use roads under the Free Movement Collection Scheme.
- ‘(2) The owner of a registered vehicle incurring levies exceeding the credit in the owner’s account, will incur charges.
- ‘(3) Excess charges will be based on the amount of levies incurred in excess of the account credit.
- ‘(4) The free movement board will set a limit on the excess charges that can be accumulated by a single registered vehicle.
- ‘(5) The owner of a registered vehicle reaching the limit of excess charges set by the free movement board must be notified immediately of the charges incurred.
- ‘(6) Charges exceeding the limit must be paid within 2 weeks of notification.
- ‘(7) The owner of the registered vehicle failing to pay excess charges within 2 weeks will incur a fine of 100 units.
- ‘(8) Immediate suspension of the vehicle’s registration will result from a failure to pay excess charges within 1 month of notification.’.
